







Head of Studies


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Eric Kearney has been Professor of Leadership, Organizational Behavior, and Human Resource Management at the University of Potsdam since 2014. He has taught at leading universities and business schools in Germany (e.g., FU Berlin, TU Berlin, HU Berlin, Leibniz Universität Hannover) and abroad (e.g., Purdue University, Tongji University in Shanghai, FGV in Rio de Janeiro). He has published his research on leadership and teamwork in leading scientific journals (e.g., Academy of Management Journal, Organization Science, Journal of Applied Psychology). Aside from teaching in academic institutions, he regularly gives talks and conducts workshops in organizations from various sectors.





Katrine Vogelsang

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Nordisk Film Production

Katrine Vogelsang has been CEO at Nordisk Film Production since 15th of August 2022. Before she has worked as Director of Fiction from 2011 to 2022 for projects like: "Dag og nat", "Kometernes jul", "The Investigation", "DNA", "Warrior", "Rita", "Seaside Hotel", "Dicte", "Clown" and many more. She was responsible for TV 2's involvement in Danish film. From 2005 to 2011 she worked as a producer for DR Drama and has been in charge of series like "Absalons hemmelighed", "Summer", "The Pact" og "Lykke". From 2001 to 2005: Education, producer at the Danish Film School.

Nordisk Film was founded in 1906 in Valby, just outside Copenhagen, by entrepreneur Ole Olsen and is one of the world's first film companies. We still have our headquarters on the Valby lot where you will also find the world's oldest still standing film studio building.

Since our foundation we have created a raft of popular film successes and incubated many of the talents who have made their mark in both Denmark and internationally.

In 1992, Nordisk Film became part of Egmont, a Nordic media group, and has within recent years seen high growth rates. In just over five years our revenues have increased with nearly 40%, and our activities now span much wider than the film business that was our starting point. Today, Nordisk Film is among the leading entertainment companies in the Nordics involved in film and series production and distribution, cinemas, computer games, digital gifting and digital advertising.

Professor for Management, Professional Services & Sport Economics

After finishing highschool in Minden, Germany and fulfilling national service Prof. Rasche studied Sport Economics at the University of Bayreuth. Initially as external doctorate candidate, later as research associate and assistent he did his doctorate at Prof. Dr. Heymo Böhler (†) (Chair of Marketing at University of Bayreuth). Afterwards a career in business and strategy consulting for Droege & Comp. AG in Dusseldorf followed. Prof. Rasche's habilitation in the field of strategic managment was accomplished at the University of Bayreuth in his function as a Senior Scientist. In 2001 he became full-professor at the University of Potsdam and since then he owns the Chair of Management, Professional Services and Sport Economics. For several periods Prof. Rasche was the managing director and vice director of the Department of Sport Sciences. Furthermore he is a member of the founding committee of gmip Management Institute Potsdam e.V., member of the Institute for Management and Organization (IMO) e.V. and of the nation-wide task force Sport Economics as well as associate editor and copublisher for the publication series "Leadership" and "Strategisches Kompetenzmanagement" [Strategic Competence Management]. He also taught European Media Management at the University of Potsdam for several years. Prof. Rasche is passionate about running marathon and rowing.
