The **Faculty of Economics and Social Sciences** at the **University of Potsdam** announces the following professorship to be filled immediately

Junior Professorship (W1), Ernst & Young Endowed Professorship in Business, specializing in Taxation

The professorship is expected to conduct research and to teach in the business field of taxation. We especially invite applications from candidates whose research focuses on the intersections with the field of informatics (IT, digitalization, etc.).

We expect candidates to have a record of excellent research according to internationally recognized methodological standards, as evidenced by publications in leading international and national scientific journals. Applicants shall have very good skills in empirical and/or experimental methods as well as their application. A willingness to cooperate within the Faculty of Economics and Social Sciences and beyond (e.g., the taxation unit of the Law Faculty) is expressly requested.

We expect an outstanding dedication to teaching. The professorship shall offer courses particularly in the relevant bachelor's and master's degree programs and contribute to the overall coordination and support of the faculty's curricula and teaching offers in taxation.

The following application requirements for junior professors must be documented in accordance with Section 45 of the Brandenburg Higher Education Act (Brandenburgisches Hochschulgesetz, BbgHG): a completed university degree, pedagogical aptitude, and a special ability for scientific work, typically documented by a dissertation project of outstanding quality. International experience, an outstanding publication record, and teaching experience are also desirable. If the applicant has worked as a research associate (*Akademische Mitarbeiterin oder Mitarbeiter*) before or after the doctorate, then the sum total of years spent in doctoral work and employment should not be more than six.

The appointment procedure is conducted in accordance with Section 40 of the Brandenburg Higher Education Act. In accordance with Section 46 of Brandenburg Higher Education Act (Brandenburgisches Hochschulgesetz, BbgHG), employment shall initially take the form of a civil service position or an employment contract, both limited to up to four years. An extension of the position can be granted for up to a total of six years, with the junior professor's consent, if he/she has proven themselves as a university teacher.

The University strives for a balanced gender ratio at all levels. Severely disabled applicants will be given preferential consideration in the event of equal qualification. We expressly invite applications from people with migration backgrounds.
