Hygiene & Infection Prevention Guideline

In order to keep all children and parents as well as our staff safe, and to prevent a further spread of the coronavirus, we adopt the following infection prevention and hygiene guidelines:

General hygiene measures

- Staff members shall adhere to the guidelines of German infection prevention law¹ and the general recommendations² regarding hand hygiene, coughing and sneezing hygiene, distance measures etc.
- Visitors of the BabyLAB will be informed about the infection prevention measures in our institution via a notice.

Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)

- Access to the buildings requires the wearing of a medical mask, i.e. OP or FFP2 mask (except for children up to age of 6 years).
- The staff members will also wear medical masks during your visit. We will point out exception (e.g. certain examination situations) in advance.

General infection prevention

- When booking an appointment, parents will be notified that they must not come to the lab if they show flu-like symptoms.
- If visitors have displayed flu-like symptoms, the appointment will not take place.
- Please avoid bringing any additional persons apart from your child to the lab.

Distance measures

- We observe the minimum distance of 1.5 metres between two people as far as possible.

Special hygiene measures

- The lab rooms will be thoroughly ventilated before and after each test session.
- A hand washing facility as well as hand sanitiser will be available for visitors of the BabyLAB.

Contact information

- In the event of a corona infection, the contact details (name, phone number, email address) of all BabyLAB visitors can be sent to the health authorities.
