Please note that papers will be reviewed for compliance with our publication criteria. Publication as a CEPA Discussion Paper is conditional on acceptance by the editors.

- Submitting author must be current CEPA member or CEPA guest/fellow.
- The submitted paper has not yet been published elsewhere except other discussion paper series.
- The paper must fit into CEPA's current research program and fulfill CEPA's quality standards.
