About the Workshop

The aim of the workshop is to bring together leading scholars and young researchers working on topics related to entrepreneurship research. We invite contributions from various interdisciplinary backgrounds: Theoretical contributions as well as empirical research using survey evidence, laboratory experiments, neuroeconomic methods, and field experiments are welcome.

- Remuneration of Entrepreneurs

The keynote lecture will be delivered by Simon C. Parker, Associate Professor of Entrepreneurship at the Richard Ivey School of Business, University of Western Ontario. He has published over 60 peer-reviewed articles in economics, entrepreneurship and management journals, and has written and edited several books on the Economics of Entrepreneurship.

Submission

Researchers desiring to present their work at this meeting are encouraged to submit a complete paper or an extended abstract by **February 15, 2012** using the online application form available on the IZA website. Papers have to be unpublished at the time of submission. Those authors who are invited are expected to participate in the entire 2-day meeting and also be willing to act as discussants. In the case of multiple authors, please indicate the correspondence author who would be presenting the paper. It is expected that about 12 papers will be accepted for presentation over the two day meeting. Acceptance decisions will be announced by March 1, 2011.
