## **Horizon Europe and the UK**

The UK Research Office in Brussels ([UKRI](#)) informs on the latest news on the UK side related to the participation of UK institutions in Horizon Europe.

The UK government announced a new package of transitional measures to ensure the stability and continuity of funding for researchers and businesses, which will come into force if the UK is not able to associate to Horizon Europe.

These transitional measures will ensure there is no funding gap for the UK R&D sector and will provide immediate funding opportunities for researchers, institutions and businesses while longer term measures are established.

The new measures include:

- funding for successful, in-flight UK-based applicants to Horizon
- uplifts to existing UK talent schemes
- uplifts to innovation funding and support for businesses, in particular SMEs
- uplifts to international innovation schemes to support international business collaborations
- funding for research institutions most affected by the loss of Horizon Europe's talent funding
- continued Third Country Participation in Horizon Europe

They will be delivered by trusted and experienced UK bodies, using existing and well-established UK funding and support mechanisms, and will be ready to launch if the UK is unable to associate to Horizon Europe.

The publication also sets out a preliminary vision for a long term, alternative programme to Horizon should it be required, which will focus on four main themes to complement the existing R&D investments: Talent, End to End Innovation, Global Collaboration and investments in the R&D system. This programme will be established as quickly as possible, and the government is already in conversation with researchers and businesses to determine priorities for a programme that would help build on UK strengths and develop new capabilities. Detailed proposals will be published soon.

The announcement also sets out the vision for Copernicus and Euratom UK alternatives, with further details expected in due course.

## Knock-on financing (Anschubfinanzierung) provided by BMBF for German coordination proposals in Horizon Europe: Next Call

The Federal Ministry for Education and Research (BMBF) offers as of spring 2021 and till September 2023 knock-on financing for the preparation of proposals within Horizon Europe with the condition that the coordinator is a German institution.

The beneficiaries of this financing are German universities, research institutions and small and medium enterprises (SMEs) acting as coordinator in a Horizon Europe proposal. The funding amounts to € 50.000, -/proposal with a maximal duration of twelve months. The knock-on financing will support network meetings, workshops, travel and stay costs and is restricted to the “Global Challenges” in Pillar II.

This funding follows the guidelines of BMBF and will be announced through the usual BMBF “Förderbekanntmachungen”. 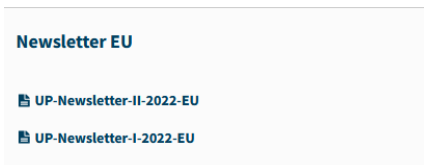
