We are looking forward to an international colorful celebration of sports - for more recognition and social participation of people with intellectual disabilities.

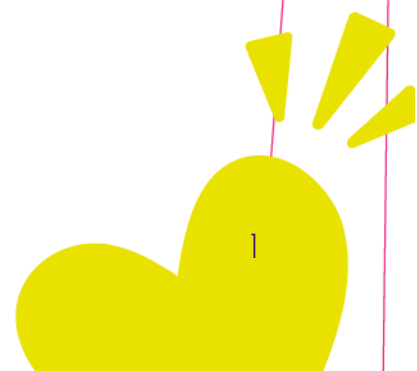

## Positions for Sport Presentation at Special Olympics National Games Berlin 2022

### **Sport Presentation Manager**

The Sport Presentation (SPP) Manager is the producer of the live event and is essentially responsible for enhancing the atmosphere and ensuring that the spectator and athlete experience is outstanding. The SPP manager calls the show, meaning that the SPP manager, over a communications network cues announcers, audio, video and scoreboard operators, ceremonies, athlete entrances, and all other aspects that require timed cueing.

### **Sport Presentation Assistant**

Member of the presentation team will work very closely with the Sport Presentation Manager to manage the administrative logistics and resources for the team, as well as assist in developing the event documentation and content to deliver a successful Sport Presentation program. Assist the Sport Presentation Manager in producing and delivering the crucial elements of the Sport Presentation program in an integrated manner, to create the most engaging experience for spectators and broadcast audiences possible.

### **The Field of Play (FOP) Manager**

Member of the presentation team responsible for manage all activities around the field of play, including but not limited to; athlete entry, live entertainment and crowd interaction segments.

### **Awarding Ceremonies (AWC) Manager**

Member of the presentation team responsible to manage, organize and oversees all procedures for Awards. Responsible for training all awards Volunteers.

### **Awarding Ceremonies Coordinator**

Member of the presentation team responsible to assist the Ceremony Manager with the organization of the awards prepared and on the awards tray in a timely manner and the marshaling procedure.

## Timeline for Special Olympics National Games Berlin 2022

### SPP Manager & SPP Assistant & FOP Manager

- June 1-25<sup>th</sup> for SPP Manager  
Workshop/training at 2-3 days for 2-4 hours each day
- June 13-24<sup>th</sup> for SPP Assistant & FOP Manager  
Workshop/ training 1-2 days for 2-4 hours
- June 16-19<sup>th</sup> for all  
Practice and training at the venue with the team. Not more than 4-5 hours daily
- June 20-21-22-23-24<sup>th</sup> for all  
Games times. Some sports have less days. Competition can last from 7-10 hours

### AWC Manager & AWC Coordinator

- June 13-25<sup>th</sup> for AWC manager  
Workshop/ training at 1-2 days for 2-4 hours each
- June 14-24<sup>th</sup> for AWC coordinator  
Workshop/ training at 1-2 days for 2-4 hours each
- June 16-19<sup>th</sup>  
Practice and training at the venue with the team. Not more than 4-5 hours daily
- June 21-22-23-24<sup>th</sup>  
Games times. Some sports have less days.
