

The **University of Potsdam, Faculty of Human Sciences, Structural Unit Cognitive Sciences, Department of Psychology**, invites applications for the following position to be filled by fall 2022:

Professorship (W 2) for Psychological Research Methods, Statistics, and Evaluation

The successful candidate will have an excellent national and international track record of research in the subject area of the professorship, both in terms of relevant publications and the acquisition of external funding. Applicants should have a research profile that will complement the university's research focus on cognitive sciences and/or specialize in clinical psychology research. Candidates are expected to be willing to participate in the university's cooperation projects such as the Collaborative Research Center SFB1287.

The new professor will teach psychological research methods, statistics, and evaluation in the B.Sc. and M.Sc. programs in Psychology; teaching contributions to cognitive science programs would also be particularly welcome. The requirements of the PsychThApprO (licensing regulations for psychotherapists) are to be taken into account with regard to course contents. Relevant teaching experience, high didactic competencies, and an above-average commitment to teaching are expected. Undergraduate courses are to be taught in German.

The successful candidate is expected to implement open science practices. Experience in and contributions to administrative tasks of the faculty are also expected.
