Transformations: Social and Cultural Dynamics in the Digital Age

Scientists from all over Europe are called upon to jointly research the foundations and consequences of digitisation in culture and society. The German participation in the funding measure is managed by the DLR Project Management Agency on behalf of the Federal Ministry of Education and Research (BMBF). CHANSE will support new and innovative research into the workings, meaning and consequences of transformations and innovations in the present digital age, viewed through the lens of the social and cultural dynamics. Whilst the call text does not preclude comparison with or investigation into other regions, every proposal must demonstrate a strong European dimension, i.e. investigating the changes taking place/affecting Europe as a whole, or at the level of a European country, city, community, etc.

Project-related individual exchange programme (various countries)

21 May 2021

The focus is on initiating or intensifying partnership-based research activities between a German and a foreign higher education institution and/or research institution in order to strengthen academic relations. Special emphasis is placed on the qualification of young academics. The programme promotes mobility and short-term stays for the exchange of university members of the participating partner institutions, especially young academics, for research stays. Funding is provided for graduate students, doctoral students, post-doctoral students, university lecturers, unless otherwise agreed with the foreign partner, see "Country-specific conditions".

Recovery, Renewal and Resilience in a Post-Pandemic World

14 June 2021

The COVID-19 pandemic is a major crisis that touches on all aspects of health, social, economic, political, and cultural life. The T-AP research call aims to address key gaps in our understanding of the dynamic and complex interaction of medium and long-term societal effects of the COVID-19 pandemic. This understanding, in turn, should advance knowledge of how to mitigate the negative societal effects of the COVID-19 pandemic and support recovery and renewal in a post-pandemic world. Applicants are required to submit novel interdisciplinary and significant research proposals in the social sciences and humanities.
