Writing consulting for students of the Faculty of Human Sciences

The writing consulting is an offer for students enrolled at the Faculty of Human Sciences who are facing difficulties at different points of the writing process for their writing assignments.

The peer-tutors aim to help students by (1) listening to their problems and questions, and (2) suggesting different methods and writing techniques to solve their difficulties with the writing process. The approach is student-centered and primarily focused on the development of writing skills (rather than the specific texts). The writing consulting at the Faculty of Human Sciences is primarily directed at international students but open to all students enrolled at the faculty. Weave Lead Agency Initiative: Cooperation with GACR (Czech Republic) launched

The Weave Lead Agency Procedure (Weave) developed by European funding organisations to support excellent collaborative research across borders was launched in December 2020. By means of a single review process, the initiative aims to simplify the submission and selection procedures for closely integrated collaborative research proposals involving researchers from up to three European countries or regions. The Deutsche Forschungsgemeinschaft (DFG, German Research Foundation) already applies Weave together with FWF (Austria), FNR (Luxembourg) and SNSF (Switzerland). From 22 February 2021 on, the cooperation with GACR (Czech Republic) commences and opens up new collaboration opportunities.

This understanding, in turn, should advance knowledge of how to mitigate the negative societal effects of COVID-19 pandemic and support recovery and renewal in a post-pandemic world.
