New Edition of the French-German Call for Proposals in the Natural, Life and Engineering Sciences

1 December 2020

The French Agence Nationale de la Recherche (ANR) and the Deutsche Forschungsgemeinschaft (DFG, German Research Foundation) are continuing their annual joint calls for French-German projects in the Natural, Life and Engineering Sciences. For the 2021 edition of this call, ANR will act as the lead agency, i.e., joint proposals describing the bilateral projects as a whole have to be submitted firstly to ANR, which will be responsible for processing proposals and conducting the review process. The DFG will require a copy of the proposal documents to be submitted on its web portal for proposal submissions.
