The aim of the programme is to establish lasting cooperation between foreign and German higher education institutions through bilateral student and lecturer exchanges. German higher education institutions can apply for language course and tutoring funds to support students and alumni (also using digital formats), funds for short-term lectureships for German and foreign university teachers and funds for contact trips by project participants from the German higher education institution to the foreign partner institution. Funding is available for German and foreign students and German and foreign lecturers.

The initiative’s aim is to provide funding for integrated Polish-German research projects of outstanding scientific quality. “Beethoven CLASSIC 4” is the continuation of a successful funding initiative which is open to research projects in the humanities and social sciences.
