**Adjunct professor/researcher (non-permanent)  
in English Linguistics (75%)  
with a focus on  
Conversation Analysis/ Interactional Linguistics or CA-SLA**

The appointment will be part-time (30 hours/ week), preferably starting on October 1st, 2020 and lasting for 24 months.

Our chair hosts both undergraduates and graduates planning to qualify for teaching positions as well as other professional fields connected with language. We investigate present-day English in talk-in-interaction and are especially interested in developing university courses based on Conversation Analysis and Interactional Linguistics (<http://www.uni-potsdam.de/iaa-pde-ll/index.html>). At our Research Centre "Interactional Linguistics" (<http://www.uni-potsdam.de/en/ilup/index.html>), we also offer exciting opportunities for collaborative research at the University of Potsdam and beyond.

**Responsibilities**

The appointee will contribute to the chair's research and publication as well as teaching, examination, and administrative duties and projects. In particular, responsibilities will include 2.25 BA/ MA courses per term – with terms lasting from October to February and April to July and 90min course time/week – in linguistics and/or applied linguistics.

**Requirements:**

We are looking for a colleague who ideally holds a PhD, preferably in (English) linguistics, who is experienced in teaching at the university level and in working with CA/ interactional-linguistic methodology. (S)He should share our team's enthusiasm for studying talk-in-interaction and sharing that knowledge with beginners and advanced students. Competence in the German language would be helpful.

The salary scale is '13 TV-Länder', amounting to a gross salary of appr. 2,800 to 3,300 EUR/ month, commensurate with qualifications and experience. The appointment will be made until September 2022 (an extension is possible and subject to funding, performance, and mutual agreement).
