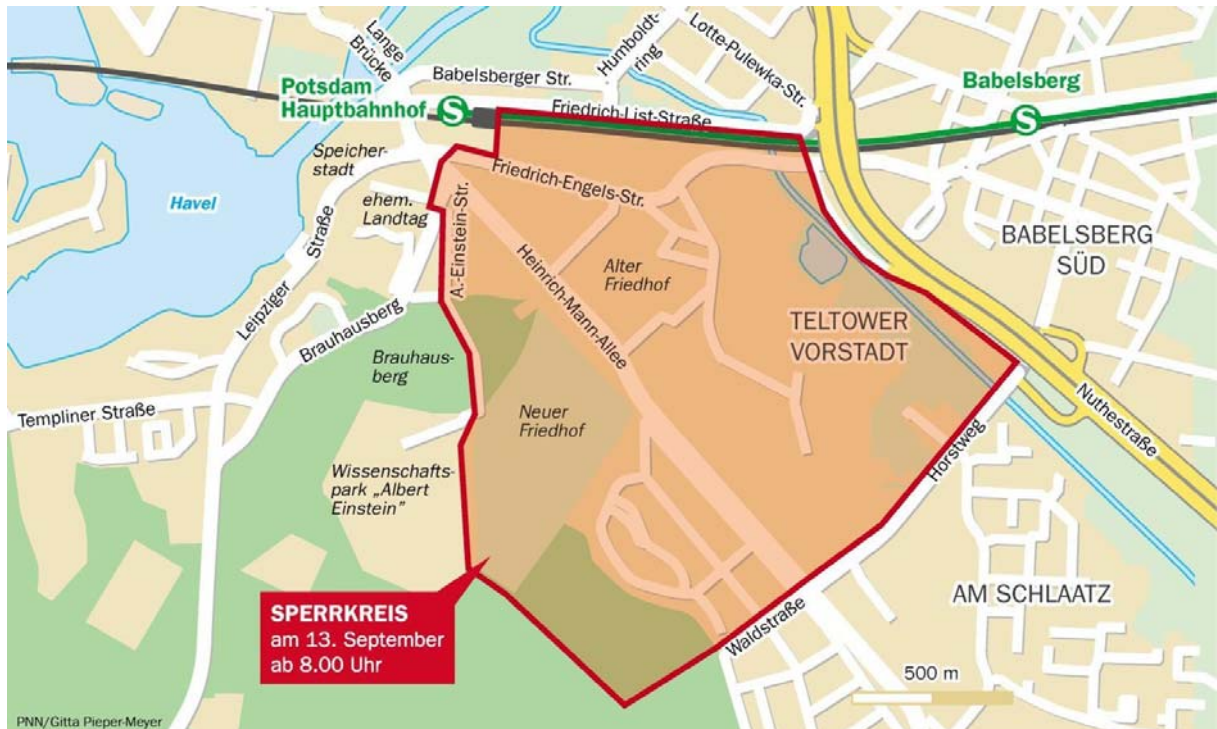


PLEASE NOTE!

On Thursday, an unexploded World-War II bomb will be defused in Potsdam. An area of 800 metres surrounding the bomb will be inaccessible (see Figure). Unfortunately, the S-Bahn between Potsdam Central Station (Potsdam Hauptbahnhof) and Babelsberg is affected and will not operate while the bomb is defused. All residents and visitors have to leave the area by 8.00 am and the bomb should be defused before noon. During that time, the central train station is closed down with no trains arriving at or departing the station. Trains coming from Berlin will be redirected.



PLEASE CHECK:

- Does your hotel lie within the red framed area? IF YES, you have to leave the area before 8.00 am.
- If you stay at a hotel in Potsdam outside the framed area, everything should be alright. However, to be sure, plan more time to travel.
- If you stay in a hotel in Berlin, please check your route and schedule via the app “DB Navigator”. Plan more time to travel from Berlin to Potsdam on Thursday morning.
