Your abstract should include:

- Title (max. 15 words)
- Author(s) and affiliation(s)
- Abstract (max. 500 words)
- 3–5 keywords
- Indicate submission type: Research-based or Practice-based

EXPECTED TIMELINE:

- Submission of abstracts: by October 31, 2025
- Notification of abstract acceptance: by December 15, 2025
- Submission of full papers: by early May 2026
- Double-blind peer review: by July 2026
- Submission of revised papers: August 2026
- Final publication: Early 2027
