- *We are responsible for more than 30.000 students in Potsdam, Brandenburg an der Havel & Wildau*



Living in the residence hall

The Studierendenwerk Potsdam provides accommodation in 18 residence halls

- Demand for rooms in the residence halls is extremely high, yet we only have space for approximately 10% of all students.
- If you are interested, be sure to apply quickly and select multiple locations and room options . Please note that you can only apply for the next semester! The application period for the winter term 2026/27 begins in May.

The rental contract

The monthly rent includes:

- Basic rent, heating costs, operational costs as well as electricity
- The room is furnished with a bed, a wardrobe, a shelf, a table and a chair

The monthly rent (average € 320) is due on the first day of the month, and the Studierendenwerk **must receive the payment by the third day of the month at the latest.**

Important: You cannot terminate your rental contract early. If you move out before the contract ends, you are still obligated to pay rent until the contract's conclusion.



You must pay rent during the whole rental period / until the semester ends (6 months)

Moving In

Room handover

Moving in: Handover Certificate

- Please inform the caretaker if you notice any existing damage.
- Sign the handover certificate provided by the caretaker after moving in.

Further important information

- GEZ (radio and television fees)
- Internet
- Registration at the city hall
- Certificate of enrollment (immatriculation certificate by semester start at the latest)
- Bedding-Set includes 1 pillow, 1 blanket, 1 bedsheet and bed linen

Moving Out

Room return

Is your tenancy agreement coming to an end and you're preparing to move out? Here are two important steps to help ensure you get your deposit back:

1. Preliminary inspection: We will schedule this appointment with your caretaker and notify you 6 weeks before your rental contract expires.
2. Final inspection: Schedule the date directly with the caretaker to hand over the keys and finalize the moving-out process.

The caretaker will document a protocol for both appointments and provide you with a copy of each.



House Rules and Emergencies

Main rules

- Cleanliness: Keep your room, kitchen, bathroom, and all shared spaces tidy. Remember to separate your rubbish and refrain from smoking in common areas!
- Noise: Please avoid loud noise between 1:00 and 3:00 PM, as well as between 10:00 PM and 6:00 AM.
- Rooms: If you are planning to drill holes, please consult the caretaker beforehand.
- No pets are allowed.
