The name Bar-Ilan was chosen, in honor of Rabbi Meir Bar-Ilan (Berlin), a spiritual leader who led traditional Judaism from the ashes of Europe to rebirth and renaissance in the Land of Israel. He inspired the founding of Bar-Ilan University in Ramat Gan (1955) by the American Mizrachi movement, and it was named for him.
