About The Society of Edith Stein House was established in 1989 as one of the first non-government related organizations, when political situation in Poland changed and allowed for registration of this type of society. In 1990 the House received a landmark status from a Historical Preservation Body. In 1995 the Society of ESH got the House back and the decision was made to restore it to its former glory and find a way to keep the House.

Activities Now completely renovated, the House and its Society is fully devoted to Jewish-Christian understanding, Polish-German reconciliation and the development of civic society in PL. Intercultural dialogue is the base for all projects ran in the Edyta Stein's House. Among those projects are lectures, youth seminars, concerts, talks, meetings, exhibitions, workshops and even language courses.

The main aim for Edith Stein House is to be an important address in Wroclaw, known for its intercultural, religious and scientific endeavours and activities.
