VISITING STUDENT PROGRAM

- Students from non-partner universities can study at HUFS as fee-paying students for one semester or one academic year while receiving benefits equal to those of exchange students. (1 semester fee: Approximately 3,500 USD)

ELIGIBILITIES

- Completed at least one semester at home university
- GPA: over 2.5 out of 4.0
- Meet the minimum level of language requirements
 - a. Korean: TOPIK 3 (or equivalent)
 - b. English: TOEFL iBT 80 (or equivalent)

The Center for Korean Language and Culture (CKLC) at Hankuk University of Foreign Studies is a forerunner of high-quality Korean language and culture education institution. Established in 1974, CKLC has been educating numerous foreigners and overseas Koreans, and about 2,000 students come to CKLC to learn and experience Korean language and culture every year.

MAIN FEATURES OF THE CKLC

- Multinational classes with students from about 100 countries around the world

LEARNER-CENTERED EDUCATION SYSTEM

- Summer: Jun. 5 – Aug. 14

FEES

- Application fee: KRW 60,000 (Non-refundable)
- Tuition Fee: KRW 1,630,000 (per semester)
- For exchange students, CKLC Fall and Spring terms are offered free of charge.
(Winter and Summer terms are offered at 30% discounted rate: KRW 1,120,000)


