#### 1. day: Sulaimaniyah

### 2. day: Sulaimaniyah

Official visits in Sulaimaniyah. 10:00 Meeting with P. Jens Petzold, Deir Maryam Al-Adhra (Chaldean Church). 12:15 Visit Horizon NGO. Lunch. 15:30 Visit Religion Faculty of Slemani University. Dinner at local private houses. Overnight in Sulaimaniyah.

#### 3. day: Halabja

09:30 Departure to Halabja. Trip to the Province of Halabja near Iranian Border. In Halabja Memorial Cemetery to the Victims of Gas Attack in 1988. Hawar Village. Meeting with Representatives of Kakaï Community. One night in private houses in the Halabja Region.

## 4. day: Halabja – Sulaimaniyah - Erbil

Halabja Region – Sulaimaniyah. Friday Prayer Darussalam Mosque. Dukan Lake. In the afternoon arrival in Erbil. Check-in Hotel Cristal. Invitation to Dinner. Five nights in Erbil.

### 5. day: Erbil

Sightseeing, Visit to City Center. Citadel, Kayseri-Bazar. 11:30 Joint Prayer in Citadel Auditorium. Official Visits. Dinner. 21:30 Meeting with Archbishop Warda at St. Joseph's Cathedral in Ainkawa. 22:00 Easter Liturgy.

#### 6. day: **Erbil** – official meetings

Official visits. 10:00 Visit Erbil Governor. Religious and Political Authorities. In the afternoon free time disposal for students – preparation for conference. Dinner in Erbil.

#### 7. day: Erbil – Conference University

09:00 Academic Conference with Ishik University, Catholic University and Salahaddin University in Erbil (v. invitation, academic schedule). Reception. Overnight in Erbil.

# 8. day: Erbil – Workshop University

10:00 Academic Workshop for Students and Lecturers (v. separate panel program). Overnight in Erbil.

# 9. day: German-Iraqi Joint Trip – Erbil - Lalish – Amedi - Dohuk

In the afternoon arrival at Amadiya/Amedi town (Qubhan-Islam-School from 17. century; casual climbing the 500 years old Minaret tower). In the afternoon arrival at Dohuk, visit St. Ith Llaha Church (viewpoint). Check-in Hotel in Dohuk. Dinner Banquet.

### 10. day: German-Iraqi Joint Trip – **Dohuk – Alqosh – Rabban Hormizd - Erbil**

Evtl. 10:00 Visit Dohuk Governor. Departure 11:00 to Alqosh. Lunch. Meeting in Bishop's House with Father Aram Qayea, Father Dr. Salar Kajo, Nineveh Reconstruction Committee. Visit Synagogue, tomb of Prophet Nahum. Walk 3 km to Eastsyrian Monastery Rabban Hormizd (7th century). In the evening arrival in Erbil. Dinner. 23:00 Departure to Erbil Airport. Arrival Erbil Airport 23:30.
