

## Printing Instructions

- 1. Print all materials in duplex mode, ideally in color, on **DIN A4 paper.** Verify that "Flip to long edge" or "Rotate sheet over long side" is selected in the **print settings**. Make sure that "Adjust", "Fit to page", or "Fit to print area" is also selected. These can typically be found under "Page Setup" or "Other Settings" in the printer menu.
- **2. Rulebook:** Place pages 1 to 6 on top of each other. Check that the sheets are arranged in ascending order and **fold** the sheets in half to create the rule book.
- **3. Game Board:** The game board is printed on pages 7 to 14. Cut out the marked areas and **glue** the individual pieces together as indicated. First, glue the upper pieces together (LS phases 1 and 2). Then the lower pieces (LS phases 3 and 4). Finally, glue the lower pieces (LS phases 3 and 4) to the upper game board pieces (LS phases 1 and 2).
- **4. Logbook:** Staple pages 15 through 20 together to create the logbook.
- **5. Lesson plan:** The lesson plan on pages 21 and 22 is ready to use.
- **6. Cards:** Cut out all quiz cards, action cards, teacher cards, student cards, and observation cards, as well the "Learning Activity Curves" (pages 23–72).
- **7. Token:** You can use any available token for this game. If you do not have one available, you can use our print-out version (page 73) to build your own.
- **8. Victory points:** On page 73 you will also find the victory points. Cut them out and pile them up.

Now you are ready to start playing!
