Ulrike Lucke, Professor for <u>Complex Multimedia Application Architectures</u> at the University of Potsdam with the Transfer Award 2023.

This year's Guido Reger Founder Award is granted to the EXISTsupported start-up team <u>"memodio</u>" for developing their app "memodio" to improve the quality of life of people suffering from forgetfulness and other cognitive impairments. Congratulations!



## University of Potsdam in 3rd Place in Stifterverband Start-Up Ranking

In the current <u>"Gründungsradar</u>", the Germany-wide start-up ranking of the Stifterverband für die Deutsche Wissenschaft, the University of Potsdam once again took 3rd place. The result shows that the University of Potsdam, with its excellent and holistic transfer structures, has developed into one of the best start-up universities in Germany. We are very pleased and motivated by this! The start-up radar has been conducted since 2012 by the Stifterverband in cooperation with the Federal Ministry for Economic Affairs and Climate Protection. For the first time, the set of indicators was expanded to include questions on the topic of sustainability and its integration into start-up support.
