



Update – Uni-list-e-mail from Prof. Andreas Musil, 17 June 2021

Dear Sir or Madam, dear students, dear colleagues,

Things are coming thick and fast and everything is happening at the same time but fortunately towards a significant improvement of the situation. Therefore, I would like to briefly present the changes for teaching and studying resulting from the replacement of the containment regulations by the contact regulations ([Umgangsverordnung](#)) as of June 15:

1. The testing obligation does not apply if the incidence is below 20 for more than five days. This is the case for Potsdam. Therefore, as of now and until further notice there is no need to provide evidence of a negative test result before the start of on-site attendance event at the University of Potsdam.
2. In seminar rooms and lecture halls, students are no longer required to wear a mouth/nose mask as soon as they have taken a seat and are at least one meter away from the next person.
3. The distance to be maintained between fixed seats is generally reduced to one meter. A corresponding re-evaluation of the rooms is expected to be available [here](#) on Friday.

Further easing is to be expected. We particularly hope for further modifications of the minimum distances.
