

2G verification document – Uni-list-Mail from Prof. Andreas Musil, 23 December 2021

Dear Sir or Madam, dear students,

We would like to organize the inspection procedures for the 2G model to be used at the University of Potsdam from January 2022 for courses (Section 25 subsection 4 in conjunction with Section 7 subsection 2 of the Second SARS-CoV-2 Containment Ordinance (2. SARS-CoV-2-EindV)) as effectively as possible. To this end, in addition to increasing the density of 2G status checks, a separate and individualized 2G verification document will be introduced for all students. It will be valid until March 31, 2022.

The verification document is so distinctive in appearance that inspection teams can check it as you walk by, and teaching staff can also ask attendees of a lecture to hold it up.

What needs to be done now? When and where is it possible to have the document validated? We would like to ask all students to download the document via https://www.uni-potsdam.de/fileadmin/projects/verwaltung/2G-Nachweis-interaktiv.pdf, fill it out in advance and then print it out in color if possible. You can add a photo electronically or glue it on. You can have your 2G verification document validated at the following locations during the week of January 10 – 14, 2022:

Am Neuen Palais campus Foyer of the AudiMax (Building 8) Room: 1.08.0.60 **09:00** a.m. – **03:30** p.m.

Golm campus
Foyer of the IKMZ (Building 18/University Library)
09:00 a.m. – 03:30 p.m.

Griebnitzsee campus Foyer of Building 6 09:00 a.m. – 03:30 p.m.

Validation can also be carried out by the gatekeepers at the Golm and Am Neuen Palais locations. The location for validation at Griebnitzsee campus has not yet been established; information on this will be provided at a later date.

For validation, please bring your student ID and proof that you have been vaccinated or have recovered in addition to the 2G verification document you have already filled out in advance. You should preferably provide us with the QR codes of the "Corona-Warn-App", CovPass or the printed out version to prove your vaccination/recovered status. The 2G certificate will then be checked using the "CovPassCheck" app. After that, your document will be marked with a security hologram sticker and thus be validated.

Where do I get my 2G verification document?

You can find the document at https://www.uni-potsdam.de/fileadmin/projects/verwaltung/2G-Nachweis-interaktiv.pdf. Once you have filled out the interactive document, print it out and then present it at one of the validation sites, along with a photo, your student ID and your proof of recovery or vaccination (QR code).

What do I do if I do not have a printer?

A limited number of verification documents will be available at the validation sites. Please remember to bring a photo of yourself in the passport format.

What do I do if I am exempt from vaccination?

Individuals who cannot be vaccinated due to a medical contraindication and for whom no vaccination recommendation has therefore been issued by the Standing Commission on Vaccination (STIKO) are exempt from the 2G rule and will not receive a 2G verification document. They must provide proof of the medical reasons by means of a written medical certificate in the original (cf. Section 7 subsection 1 no. 4b of the 2nd SARS-CoV-2-EindV). In addition, proof of daily testing must be on hand (no self-tests).

What do I do if I am not considered fully vaccinated until after January 3?

Until January 31, 2022, there is an additional exemption from the 2G rule for those who can demonstrate that they will be fully vaccinated by then. For this purpose, a daily test (not a self-test), proof of the second vaccination date or, from January 17 at the latest, proof of the last vaccination is mandatory.
