



Motivation Letter (for the Master's Degree Program in Economic Policy and Quantitative Methods) – Requirements:

To apply for the Master in Economic Policy and Quantitative Methods, we expect you to submit a letter of motivation. The requirements for this letter are as follows:

- Language of the Motivation Letter: English
- Maximum length: Two standard pages (i.e. a maximum of 3,600 characters including spaces per page)
- The quality of your motivation letter counts 25% of your total point value. Other factors that determine your total point value: 50% average grade or current average grade, 25% average grade in quantitative subjects (statistics, econometrics and mathematics)
- Content: Your motivation letter should answer the following questions:
 - 1. Why do you want to study Economic Policy and Quantitative Methods?
 - 2. What prior knowledge (academic or practical experience) and competences do you possess that are relevant to the Master's degree program in Economic Policy and Quantitative Methods?
 - 3. What is the role of evidence-based economic policy in society today?
