



## Job Announcement

The **University of Potsdam, Faculty of Human Sciences, Department of Linguistics** invites applications for the following position:

### Temporary Visiting Professorship position

Starting from 01. October 2020 for a duration of 6 months (fixed-term contract; pending the approval of the university committees).

The position includes teaching responsibilities of 8 SWS (4 classes) at the Bachelor- and Master-level in Neurolinguistics (e.g., Introduction to Neurolinguistics, Foundations of Scientific Working incl. written examinations). The teaching language of the BSc classes is German; the teaching language of the MSc classes is English.

The candidate will work in a highly invigorating educational and scientific environment in the Linguistics Department. The Department has excellent research opportunities including several laboratories.

#### Prerequisites for this position are:

- The candidate must hold a degree in linguistics, psychology, or cognitive science
- Additional scientific achievements in the area of neuro/psycholinguistics must be documented by a PhD/Promotion and at least three years of successful postdoctoral work or a Habilitation in neuro/psycholinguistics or a related field (in accordance with the requirements of § 41 BbgHG).
- Teaching experience is required
- A very good command of German and English is required for this position

The University of Potsdam aims to increase the proportion of women in research and teaching and therefore invites qualified applicants to apply. The University of Potsdam values the diversity of its members and pursues the goals of equal opportunities regardless of gender, nationality, ethnic and social origin, religion/belief, disability, age, sexual orientation or identity. In the case of equal suitability, women within the meaning of Section 7 (4) BbgHG and severely disabled people will be given preferential consideration.
