



APPLY NOW FOR THE PROCOPE MOBILITY GRANT 2026



Service pour la Science et la Technologie Abteilung für Wissenschaft und Technologie

Liberté Égalité Fraternité

With the Procope-Mobility grant program, the Office for Science and Technology Service of the French Embassy in Germany supports the mobility of young researchers affiliated with a university or a research institute in Germany to France. These mobility grants fund research stays of one, two, or three months at a university or research institute in France. Research stays must begin between May 18, 2026 and December 31, 2026.

Applicants must be:

- doctoral students, postdoctoral researchers, or early-career researchers (within five years of their doctoral defense);
- affiliated with a German university or research institute.

Program beneficiaries will receive a fixed monthly allowance of €1,850 for doctoral candidates and €2,100 for other young researchers.

Applications must be **submitted by January 12, 2026** (11:59 p.m. Paris time) via the LYYTI application platform (which can be modified until the deadline).






CHRISTMAS GARDEN BERLIN

19th November - 11th January


From mid-November 2024, the Botanical Garden in Dahlem will once again open its doors every vening and invite visitors to take a very special walk in the "Christmas Garden Berlin", where visitors can spend a contemplative evening in dreamy surroundings on a tour of around one and a halfkilometers. Over 1 million points of light, 3000 fairy lights and a multitude of colorful illuminations immerse the Botanic Garden in a pre-Christmas sea of lights, and guests young and old can also linger over regional dishes in the "Almhütten" restaurant. Other highlights include a starry forest, a glowworm garden, Rudolph and his friends, an enchanted forest and a bell chime.







CHRISTMAS IN THE "TIERGARTEN" 21st November 2025 - 10th January 2026



From November 21, 2025 to January 10, 2026, Weihnachten im Tierpark turns Berlin's Tierpark into a glowing winter landscape. Along a 2-km path, visitors can enjoy magical light installations, illuminated trees, and festive scenes around Schloss Friedrichsfelde. Highlights include an ice rink, fire garden, seasonal food stalls, and immersive soundscapes. Open daily from late afternoon, the source offers timed-entry tickets that should be booked in advance online.

The historic Gerichtshöfe in Berlin-Wedding host the unique art fair Kunst im Karton. Twenty-three artists present their works inside recycled fruit and vegetable boxes measuring 30 x 40 cm. The range spans painting, objects, photography, jewelry, and collage, with each piece priced at no more than €250. Once a box is sold, a new artwork takes its place, ensuring constant discovery. Visitors can explore a total of 276 boxes while enjoying mulled wine, apple punch, and cookies in a festive atmosphere. More info
