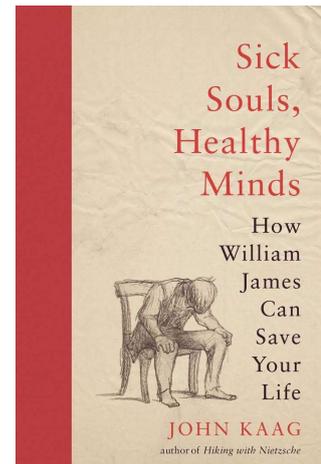
The participants in the workshops are expected to have read John Kaag’s book *Sick Souls, Healthy Minds: How William James Can Save Your Life*.
