# <u>Certificate in "Intercultural Competence in Academic and Professional</u> Contexts"

#### **Self-Managed Learning with Consultations**

Zessko supports course-independent learning through professional learning consultants and certified peer tutors:

- <u>independent study with supervision</u> and <u>language tandems</u>
- <u>writing assistance</u> in German and English individual, process-oriented support for assignments and final theses, writing groups, and workshops
- <u>presentation coaching</u> individual consultations for scholarly presentations (seminar papers, moderation of group discussions, dissertation defenses, etc.); support of instruction by helping with seminar presentations, etc.

### **Successful Start in University Studies for International Students (ESIST)**

The University of Potsdam is a member of the Brandenburg university network that supports and is named after ESiST. The program includes:

- the one-year course "Preparing for Studies in Brandenburg," which allows students to
  acquire the higher education entrance qualification for the state of Brandenburg (linguistic,
  subject-specific and intercultural preparation, with an additional focus on academic
  languages and methodologies)
- University entrance examination (**HZP**)
- German Language Exam for University Admission (DSH), including preparation
- Intensive German courses for refugees at different CEFR levels
- Course offerings in the introductory study phase
