

November 25, 2021 E-Learning Day with presentation of the E-Learning Award

The E-Learning Day this year is focused on the **presentation of successful practice** of **social online teaching and learning** at our university and the collegial exchange about the design of e-learning scenarios. We invite all teachers at the University of Potsdam to participate.

CALL FOR PARTICIPATION

The use of digital media has made it possible for most of the teaching to take place despite the current pandemic. The central importance of contact between teachers and students, as well as among students, became particularly apparent. This is reflected not least in the increasingly expressed desire for more social interaction during studies. The current call for proposals is therefore about (media-)didactically creative ideas and proven concepts from the last semesters, in which social interaction and communication were addressed.

This year's E-Learning Day will therefore be guided by the questions:

- What creative concepts were there to enable more social learning under the special conditions?
- What impact have these approaches had on the social interactions? How was this determined?
- What teaching ideas can be beneficial within and across disciplines?

Presentation of your practical example in the context of the E-Learning Day 2021

Successful and learning-promoting e-learning practice should be made known and more fruitful for colleagues in their own subjects and beyond. Therefore, we warmly invite all teachers to submit their **concept of an implemented online course** in the form of a **short outline**, to present the concept at the E-Learning Day and to discuss transfer possibilities with all participants.

The presentation of practical examples and the awarding of the E-Learning Award 2021 "Social Online Teaching" go hand in hand again this year. As part of your submission for the E-Learning Day, you can decide whether you want to participate in the award with your practical example.

Participation in the E-Learning Award "Social Online Teaching"

To promote the quality of e-learning scenarios in university teaching, the Presidential Board of the University of Potsdam is offering the e-learning award "Social Online Teaching" this year.

Prize money with a total value of 10,000 euros will be awarded.

Procedure

From those entries that participate in the E-Learning Award, the jury will nominate 5 entries for the award. The respective teachers will be informed and will present their proven teaching concepts in a pitch at the end of the E-Learning Day. The jury and the audience (one vote) will select up to three winners.

The deadline for submissions is 25.10.2021 (12:00).

The nomination for the award by the jury is based on the guiding questions:

- Is the concept comprehensible and coherently presented?
- How well was the challenge of "social online teaching" met? (How was the e-learning
 offering integrated into the course and what quality development and quality assurance
 measures were implemented?)
- How appropriate and suitable were the methods and techniques used in relation to the target group? How diversity-sensitive was the e-learning offer designed and was it thus able to take diversity into account in teaching and studying?
- How high is the subject-specific and/or interdisciplinary transferability?
