Prerequisite for the installation process is to have central University account **[accountname]@uni-potsdam.de (UP-Account)**

Please click on the upper right corner of your desktop and then click **“Select Network”**. In the following window, please select the desired WLAN (**eduroam** or **UP-Campus**).

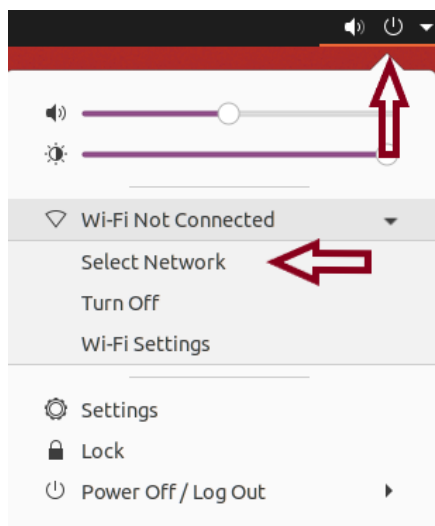

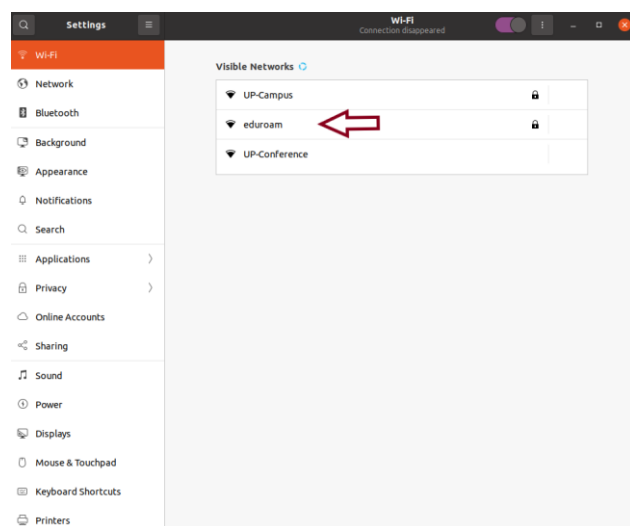

At the end click „Connect“

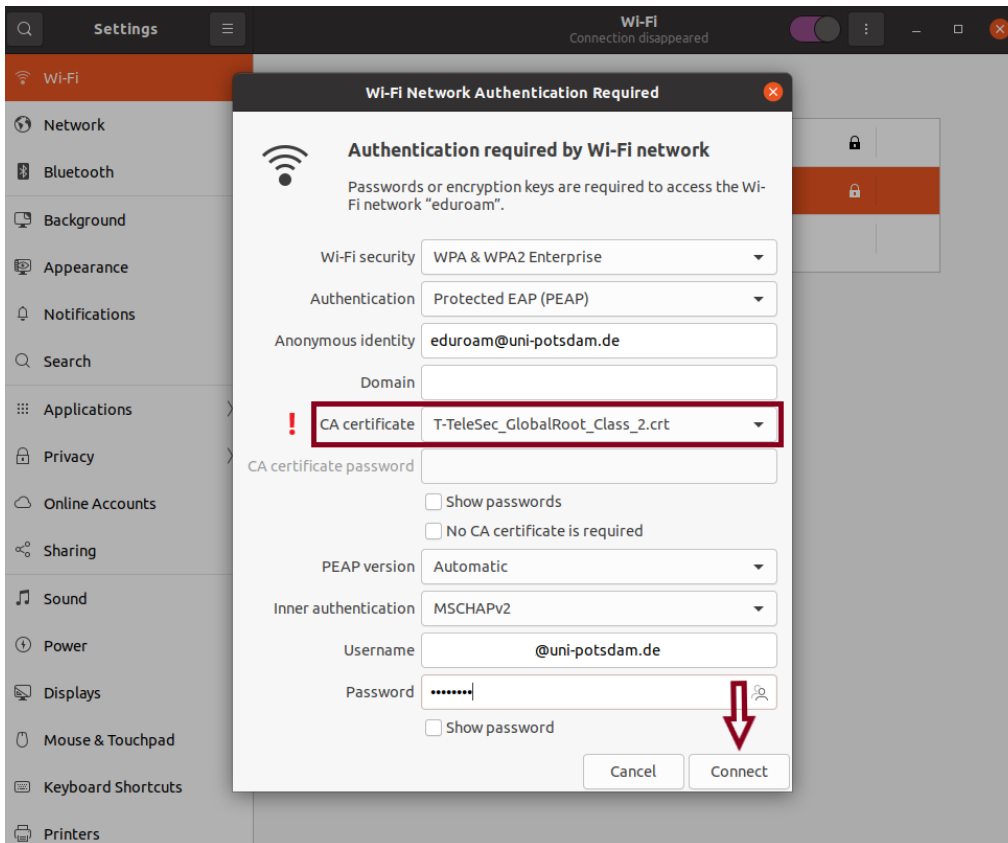

After successful connection, the following window will be displayed.

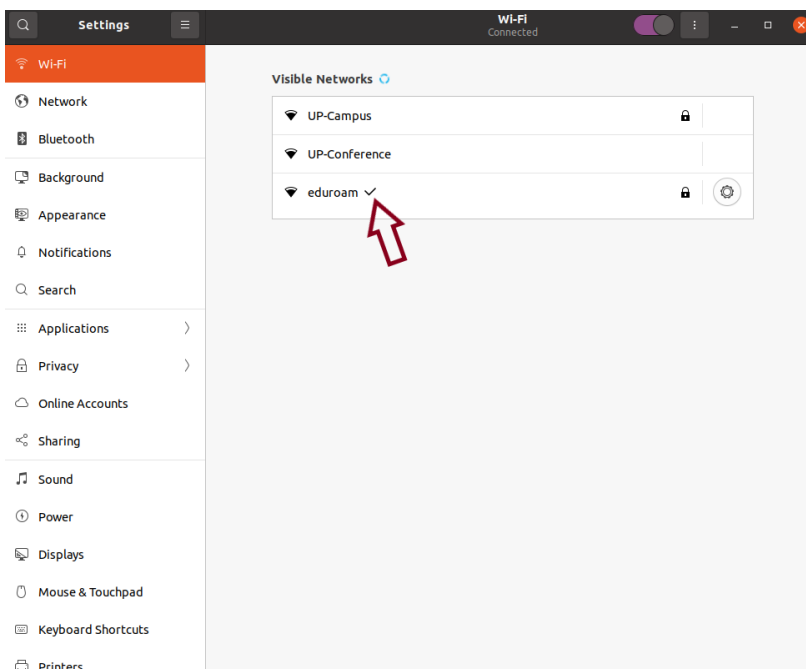
