



Orthography test vs. Freely written text

- Picture-Word-Test
 - conducted by the teacher
 - according to Sommer-Stumpenhorst teaching method
 - names of depicted items previously named by teacher
 - SEP/OCT, JAN, APR
- LAS Test 2
 - based on retelling of a short film sequence
 - MAY



Criteria of analysis: Overview

- Motoric realisation of letters
- Correct realisation of entire words
- Realisation of syllables according to syllable structure
- Representation of syllable parts
- Upper and lower case marking
- Marking of word and sentence boundaries



Orate and literate structures: Overview

- 5 areas under investigation:
 - form of complements: complexity, degree of decontextualisation
 - form of predicates: register differences
 - pragmatic and discourse phenomena: register differences
 - syntax: complexity, degree of textual coherence
 - lexical and functional peculiarities
- all forms were ranged along an orate-literate scale




Example 7th grade: Oral vs. written version

Summary of the Orate-literate-analysis, 7th grade

- The amount of literate complements is increased in the written version of both groups.
- The form of predicates hardly varies in the spoken and the written texts in both groups.
- The amount of syntactically extended structures increases in the second test compared to the first one.
- In the spoken version, connection devices are predominated by unmarked and literate types; in the written version, orate devices occur: *und dann...*, *und dann* 'and then...', and then'
- The function of the clauses is almost exclusively depicting in the written version.
