The student (research) assistant will support the research group 4 “**Data as Means of Payment**”. The group examines the **usage of data in the digital economy** from legal, psychological, technological as well as economic perspectives. One of the principal investigated issues is the exchange of personal and non-personal data in return for goods and services in digital form. The question whether the law should accept, support, set conditions or rather reject this form of transaction cannot be answered thoroughly without **investigating consumer behavior** regarding underlying **cognitive and emotional-motivational**, dynamic processes.
