At the **Faculty of Arts, Institute of Philosophy** invites applications for

Professorship (W 2) in the Philosophy of Mind and Philosophical Anthropology

to be filled by the summer semester 2020. The prospective professor is expected to be able to do research and teaching in all areas of both Philosophy of Mind and Philosophical Anthropology (in the sense of a field of research, not necessarily a philosophical tradition). In addition, a related research interest in the history of philosophy would be desirable.

The University of Potsdam has a distinguished teacher education program that acknowledges the realities of school and instruction while also incorporating the latest research findings in the field, and has a high proportion of practical exercises. The "Potsdam Model" of teacher education should be further developed in a dedicated way together with other professorships relevant to teacher training at the University of Potsdam and in cooperation with the Center for Teacher Training and Education Research. We expect a willingness to cooperate in continuing teacher education and an interest in cross-faculty collaboration.

The following application requirements for professors must be documented in accordance with Section 41 of the Brandenburg Higher Education Act (Brandenburgisches Hochschulgesetz, BbgHG): a completed university degree, pedagogical talent, and a particular aptitude for scientific and scholarly work, as is typically documented by a dissertation project; comprehensive competences in science management and additional scholarly achievements as evidenced by a Habilitation (post-doctoral dissertation), a junior professorship or work as a research associate at an institution of higher education or an extramural research institution, or scholarly activity in the private sector, or in a similar social field, whether in Germany or abroad. The appointment procedure is conducted in accordance with Section 40 BbgHG.

The University strives for a balanced gender ratio at all levels. Severely disabled applicants will be given preferential consideration in the event of equal qualification. We expressly invite applications from people with migration backgrounds.
