Full Professorship (W 3) for Music Education and Didactics

The successful candidate will have broad experience in teaching professional and didactic foundations of music instruction, in the application and the development of innovative learning environments, primarily for the secondary school level as well as for academic teaching. Responsibilities include representing the field in teaching and research, the implementation of courses for specialized content and teaching methodologies, the development of class projects for students of musical education at schools as well as the supervision of theses.

Contributions to empirical or theoretical research on teaching and learning in the field of music education and didactics are expected. Relevant publications, preferably in peer-reviewed journals, and participation in interdisciplinary research projects at the intersection of educational and musical science as well as teacher education are required. Experience with the acquisition of external funding, international networking and interdisciplinary cooperation is desired.

The University of Potsdam views the networking of scholarly research and teaching in the education of teachers as a particular challenge. The holder of the position must be able to adequately represent both fields.

The University of Potsdam has a distinguished teacher education program that acknowledges the realities of school and instruction while also incorporating the latest research findings in the field, and has a high proportion of practical exercises. The "Potsdam Model" of teacher education should be further developed in a dedicated way together with other professorships relevant to teacher training at the University of Potsdam and in cooperation with the Center for Teacher Training and Education Research. We expect a willingness to cooperate in continuing teacher education and an interest in cross-faculty collaboration.

The following application requirements for professors must be documented in accordance with Section 41 of the Brandenburg Higher Education Act (Brandenburgisches Hochschulgesetz, BbgHG): a completed university degree, pedagogical talent, and a particular aptitude for scientific and scholarly work, as is typically documented by a dissertation project; comprehensive competences in science management and additional scholar-

ly achievements as evidenced by a Habilitation (post-doctoral dissertation), a junior professorship or work as a research associate at an institution of higher education or an extramural research institution, or scholarly activity in the private sector, or in a similar social field, whether in Germany or abroad. The appointment procedure is conducted in accordance with Section 40 BbgHG.

The University strives for a balanced gender ratio at all levels. Severely disabled applicants will be given preferential consideration in the event of equal qualification. We expressly invite applications from people with migration backgrounds.
