Invitation to participate in a Seminar on

"The many Disciplines of Public Administration"

'if you want to improve the interdisciplinary field of PA, then join us'

We invite early stage researchers (PhD students and PhD + 4 years) from disciplines such as Public Administration, Administrative Law, Public Policy, Economics, Public Management, Sociology and Political Science who are interested in the relationship of different disciplines to Public Administration, both as an academic field and as an object of teaching and research. We are interested in how different disciplines relate to PA, concerning main problems and characteristics, and possible future developments.

The Seminar is part of EPPA, the 'European Perspectives for Public Administration'. More information can be found here: http://europeanperspectivespa.eu/

The seminar 'The many Disciplines of Public Administration' aims to discuss the more or less problematic links between the major disciplines that constitute the field of Public Administration. Key questions are how disciplines such as political sciences, management sciences, law, economics, ... are dialoguing, sharing, collaborating (or not) with/within PA and how this could result in more and better synergies to produce more relevant knowledge to understand the functioning of the field of public policies and administration: What can we learn and how can we cooperate across the established disciplinary boundaries, which seem to become ever more imperative and impregnable?

From a thematic point of view there will be a focus on relationships between 'PA and Political Science', 'PA and Management', 'PA and Administrative Law', and 'PA and Public Policy', 'PA and Sociology' and 'PA and ICT/eGov/Digitalization'. Each session will last 90 minutes, with three contributions, lasting max. 15 to 20 minutes each, two by experienced colleagues, and one by a younger researcher (PhD or Post-doc). The contribution should be not comprehensive, but highlight important developments and problems.

The number of participants in the stage of PhD students or early Post-Doctoral Researchers is in total limited to six. We are interested in one specific contribution to each of the sessions (see below).

Application procedure:

Please submit a) a short outline of a max. 15-minutes input for the EPPA Seminar "The many Disciplines of Public Administration" referring explicitly to one of our sessions focusing on PA and Political Science', 'PA and Management', 'PA and Administrative Law', and 'PA and Public Policy', 'PA and Sociology' and 'PA and ICT/eGov/Digitalization'.

We are interested in what in your view are the main problems, challenges or opportunities for the future development of the relationship of PA and your discipline (250 words max., in English) accompanied by b) a short CV, electronically by **April 16, 2017**. Preferably, the input is related to /an extract of your current research or your project.
